The Language Cycles research group at the MPI CBS in Leipzig investigates properties of the human brain that shape the way we process language.

We are looking for motivated interns to help with the analysis of a large-scale dataset of behavioral data from native speakers of 25 languages, recorded with a smartphone application. The data stem from two experiments in which we are aiming to find out (1) which types of speech stimuli are perceived as pleasant and (2) how listeners assemble words into word groups.

Note that there may also be the opportunity to write a thesis on the project.
